FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

PROHIBITION ON FISHING FOR DEMERSAL SCALEFISH FROM BOATS (CLOSED SEASON—WEST COAST REGION) ORDER 2024

[A14224]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the Prohibition on Fishing for Demersal Scalefish from Boats (Closed Season—West Coast Region) Order 2024.

2. Commencement

This order commences operation on gazettal.

3. Interpretation

In this order—

charter boat has the same meaning as in the regulations;
closed season has the same meaning as in regulation 45 of the regulations;
demersal scalefish has the same meaning as in regulation 45 of the regulations;
West Coast Region has the same meaning as in the regulations.

4. Prohibition on fishing for demersal scalefish

A person must not fish for demersal scalefish from a boat in the West Coast Region during the closed season.

5. Exceptions to prohibition

Subclause 4 does not apply to or in respect of a person fishing for demersal scalefish-

- (a) for a commercial purpose in accordance with an authorisation; or
- (b) during a fishing tour on a charter boat.

Logue Brook Dam

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 48A of the *Navigable Waters Regulations 1958*, I hereby cancel Notice MA402 as published in the *Government Gazette* on 20 December 2019 and set aside the following area of water for the purpose of water skiing—

Logue Brook Dam: Whilst the official water level is equal to or higher than 216 metres and less than 221 metres above the Australian Height Datum as published by the Water Corporation of Western Australia—

All those waters west of a line through 32°59.870'S, 115°58.200'E and 33°00.110'S, 115°58.350'E (approximately 1 kilometre upstream from the dam wall) excluding (i) waters in the south-west of the dam south of a line from 33°00.131'S, 115°57.735'E to 33°00.116'S, 115°57.847'E to 33°00.185'S, 115°57.877'E; and (ii) waters within 200 metres of the main dam wall. All coordinates base on GDA 94.

Providing however that skiing is not permitted with 50 metres of the foreshore except when taking off and landing. The direction of all water skiing shall be in an anti-clockwise direction and water skiing is only permitted within the hours of sunrise and sunset only.

This dam is 'Closed to Water Skiing' when the official water level is below 216 metres above Australian Height Datum, as published by the Water Corporation of Western Australia.
