Made under the *Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1911* sections 186(2)(a) and (3) and 348A(1)(a) by the Governor in Executive Council.

Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Citation

This proclamation is the *Health (Miscellaneous Provisions)* (Offensive Trades) Proclamation 2024.

2. Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation as follows —

- (a) Part 1 on the day on which this proclamation is published on the WA legislation website;
- (b) the rest of the proclamation on 4 June 2024.
