

5. Objection to application

- (1) At any time within 7 days of the publication of a notice under regulation 4 (3) a person may lodge with the Registrar a written objection to the granting of the application on the ground that the applicant is not a fit and proper person to be an industrial agent because of the criminal record of the applicant or of an officer of the body making the application.
- (2) An objection under subregulation (1) is to —
 - (a) specify the name and address of the objector;
 - (b) contain particulars of the grounds on which the objector objects to the application; and
 - (c) information in support of the grounds of objection.
- (3) The Registrar is to give the applicant a copy of any objection made to the application.
