

**21. Alternative methodology for authorized surveys in special cases**

- (1) An authorized land officer may, by written notice, authorize a departmental surveyor to carry out an authorized survey in a manner different from that required by the *Licensed Surveyors (Guidance of Surveyors) Regulations 1961* if the officer is satisfied that —
  - (a) the value of the relevant land does not justify carrying out a survey in the manner required by those regulations;
  - (b) the nature of the relevant land makes it impracticable to carry out a survey in the manner required by those regulations; or
  - (c) other special circumstances exist that justify carrying out the survey in a manner different from that required by those regulations.
- (2) An authorized land officer may vary or revoke an authorization under this regulation at any time by giving written notice to the departmental surveyor to whom the authorization was granted.
