## 29. Safety of persons boarding or leaving

- (1) The Master of a vessel, whilst it is occupying any Berth, must at all times
  - (a) provide gangways, manropes and similar appliances; and
  - (b) exhibit any lights,

as may be necessary for the convenience and safety of persons boarding or leaving the vessel.

- (2) The Master of a vessel must ensure that
  - (a) every gangway fixed for the purpose of giving access to a vessel is, from sunset to sunrise while the gangway is in communication with the shore, brightly illuminated; and
  - (b) a watch is continuously set upon the gangway.
- (3) A Master who contravenes this by-law commits an offence.
