

2. Interpretation

In this Act unless the context requires otherwise —

“**Constituent Lodge**” means a Lodge of Antient, Free and Accepted Masons, constituted, whether before or after the coming into operation of this Act, under the authority of, and owing allegiance to, Grand Lodge;

“**Grand Lodge**” means the body known as The Grand Lodge of Western Australia of Antient, Free and Accepted Masons;

“**Lodge**” means Grand Lodge, or, as the case requires, a Constituent Lodge;

“**personal property**” means property other than real property;

“**property**” means real and personal property of any kind;

“**real property**” means land and estates in land;

“**registration authority**” means an authority authorised by law to record transactions affecting, or relating to, property;

“**Trustee**” means a person appointed to, and occupying at any material time, the office of Trustee of a Lodge, in accordance with the constitution of the Lodge.
