

208. Service of notices

Without limiting section 31 (1) of the *Interpretation Act 1918*⁸, where any notice or notification is required to be served on, or given or sent to, any person under this Act, the same may be posted to him as a letter addressed to him —

- (a) at the address shown for him in the roll; or
- (b) if the person has notified a postal address to the Electoral Commissioner or the Registrar, at that postal address.
