ADDITIONAL MEASURES (CLOSURE OF CERTAIN PREMISES) AMENDMENT DIRECTIONS

The World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic on 11 March 2020.

On 15 March 2020, the Minister for Emergency Services declared a state of emergency with effect from 12 a.m. on 16 March 2020 in respect of the pandemic caused by COVID-19 pursuant to section 56 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005* (WA) (**Act**). The state of emergency applies to the State of Western Australia.

I, Christopher John Dawson, Commissioner of Police and State Emergency Coordinator, now give the following directions pursuant to my powers under sections 67, 71 and 72A of the Act.

PREAMBLE

1. The purpose of these directions is to amend the Additional Measures (Closure of Certain Premises) Directions (**Primary Directions**).

CITATION

2. These directions may be referred to as the **Additional Measures (Closure of Certain Premises) Amendment Directions**.

COMMENCEMENT

3. These directions come into effect at the time of signing.

DIRECTIONS

4. The Primary Directions are amended by inserting after paragraph 6, the following paragraph:

6A. Despite paragraph 5:

- (a) a person may play in the A-League match (or participate in a scheduled training session for that match) between Perth Glory Football Club and Melbourne City Football Club on Wednesday, 5 May 2021 scheduled to commence at 7.20 pm at HBF Park located at 310 Pier Street, Perth (**A-League match**); and

(b) for the avoidance of doubt:

(i) any person who is required to be at HBF Park for the purpose of facilitating the playing and broadcasting of the A-League match may attend HBF Park for that purpose; and

(ii) no spectators may be present at the A-League match.

5. For the avoidance of doubt, I confirm that the Primary Directions continue in effect as in force immediately before the time specified in paragraph 3 of these directions but, from that time, as amended by paragraph 4 of these directions.
