

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2005 (WA)**

**Sections 67, 70 and 72A**

**AFL 2021 PREMIERSHIP SEASON (WESTERN BULLDOGS)  
DIRECTIONS (NO 2) REVOCATION DIRECTIONS**

The World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic on 11 March 2020.

On 15 March 2020, the Minister for Emergency Services declared a state of emergency with effect from 12 am on 16 March 2020 in respect of the pandemic caused by COVID-19 pursuant to section 56 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005 (WA)* (**Act**). The state of emergency applies to the State of Western Australia.

I, Colin John Blanch, Acting Commissioner of Police and State Emergency Coordinator, now give the following directions, pursuant to my powers under sections 67, 70 and 72A of the Act.

**PREAMBLE**

1. The purpose of these directions is to revoke the AFL 2021 Premiership Season (Western Bulldogs) Directions (No 2).

**CITATION**

2. These directions may be referred to as the **AFL 2021 Premiership Season (Western Bulldogs) Directions (No 2) Revocation Directions**.

**COMMENCEMENT**

3. These directions come into effect immediately upon signing.

**REVOCATION AND CONTINUING OBLIGATIONS**

4. The AFL 2021 Premiership Season (Western Bulldogs) Directions (No 2) are revoked.
