**AFL 2021 PREMIERSHIP SEASON FINALS SERIES (GEELONG)  
AMENDMENT DIRECTIONS (NO 2)**

The World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic on 11 March 2020.

On 15 March 2020, the Minister for Emergency Services declared a state of emergency with effect from 12 am on 16 March 2020 in respect of the pandemic caused by COVID-19 pursuant to section 56 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005 (WA)* (**Act**). The state of emergency applies to the State of Western Australia.

I, Colin John Blanch, Acting Commissioner of Police and State Emergency Coordinator, now give the following directions pursuant to my powers under sections 67, 70 and 72A of the Act.

**PREAMBLE**

1. These directions amend the AFL 2021 Premiership Season Finals Series (Geelong) Directions (**Primary Directions**).

**CITATION**

2. These directions may be referred to as the **AFL 2021 Premiership Season Finals Series (Geelong) Amendment Directions (No 2)**.

**COMMENCEMENT**

3. These directions come into effect at the time of signing.

**DIRECTIONS**

4. The Primary Directions are amended by:
  - (a) deleting "paragraph 5 of the Quarantine and Isolation (Undiagnosed) Directions (No 2)" in paragraph 7, and inserting in its place "paragraph 10 of the Quarantine (Undiagnosed) Directions";
  - (b) deleting paragraph 57, and replacing it with the following paragraph:
    57. **Quarantine period**, in relation to a relevant person, means the period of 14 days commencing from the later of:
      - (a) the date and time when the relevant person was last in a restricted location prior to entering Western Australia; or

- (b) the date and time when any other relevant person who is quarantining in the same accommodation area as the relevant person was last in a restricted location prior to entering Western Australia.
- (c) deleting Schedule 1 and inserting in its place the Schedule 1 attached to these directions.
5. For the avoidance of doubt, the Primary Directions continue in effect as in force immediately before the time specified in paragraph 3 of these directions but, from that time, as amended by paragraph 4 of these directions.
