**AN ACT to appropriate and apply from the General Loan Fund certain sums to make good the supplies granted for the service of the Year ending the 30th day of June, 1969, and to supplement grants made by the last Parliament during its third Session in adjustment of the Vote "Advance to Treasurer, 1967-68," for charges during the Year ended the 30th day of June, 1968.**

Preamble.

*Most Gracious Sovereign,*

**WE**, Your Majesty's Most Dutiful and Loyal Subjects, the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the Sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent

Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say) :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act, (General Loan Fund), 1968-69.* Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied, for or towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine the sum of Thirty-four Million Four Hundred and Forty-three Thousand Dollars from the General Loan Fund. Application of moneys.

3. (1) The sum of Sixty-four Million Four Hundred and Forty-three Thousand Dollars granted by this Act, and the Acts mentioned in Schedule A to this Act, towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, is appropriated from the General Loan Fund for the purposes and services expressed in Schedule B. Appropriation of Supplies Schedules A and B

(2) The sum of Seven Million Three Hundred and Thirty-seven Thousand Two Hundred and Thirty-three Dollars and Forty-seven Cents granted by this Act to supplement grants in confirmation of the expenditure from the Vote "Advance to Treasurer, 1967-68," for charges during the Year ended the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight is appropriated from the General Loan Fund and shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in Schedule C.
