AN ACT to amend clause eleven of the First Schedule to the *Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1966.*

[Assented to 5th December, 1967.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Workers' Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1967.*
