

CONSTITUTION.

No. 2 of 1965.

AN ACT to amend the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1963.

[Assented to 13th August, 1965.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1965*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1963, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted approved for reprint 30th November, 1964.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1965.

2. Section thirty-seven of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word, "ten" in line two of the proviso to that section, the word, "twelve".

S. 43
amended.

3. Section forty-three of the principal Act is amended by substituting the word, "twelve" for the word, "ten"—

- (a) in line one of subsection (1) of that section;
and
- (b) in lines one and three of subsection (2) of that section.
