AN ACT to amend the Betting Control Act, 1954-1959.

[Assented to 2nd December, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Betting Control Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1960.*

Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Betting Control Act, 1954-1959, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Betting Control Act, 1954-1960.

2. Subsection (5) of section eleven of the principal Act is amended by adding after the figures, "1911" at the end of paragraph (a) the following passage, "except (in the case of a license under this Act entitling the holder to carry on the business of a bookmaker as mentioned in paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of this section) in the case of a spirit merchant's license or a gallon license which is located in areas of the State other than the South-West Land Division;".
