**AN ACT to amend the City of Fremantle (Free
Literary Institute) Act, 1948.**

[Assented to 1st November, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *City of Fremantle (Free Literary Institute) Act Amendment Act, 1960.*

(2) In this Act the City of Fremantle (Free Literary Institute) Act, 1948, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the City of Fremantle (Free Literary Institute) Act, 1948-1960.

2. Section eleven of the principal Act is amended ^{S. 11} amended.
by—

- (a) inserting after the word, “any” in line one of paragraph (v) of subsection (1) the words, “appointment or”;
- (b) adding after the word, “indenture” in line three of paragraph (v) of subsection (1) the words, “or in this Act.”

3. The principal Act is amended by adding a ^{S. 11A} added.
section as follows:—

11A. Notwithstanding the terms and conditions contained in Clause 7 of the said Indenture, the Mayor of the Council is hereby appointed to be *ex officio* a member of the Board of Directors so long as he remains in office in addition to the Directors referred to in Clause 7.
