**AN ACT to amend the Firearms and Guns Act.
1931-1953.**

[Assented to 4th January, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Firearms and Guns Act Amendment Act, 1956*. Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Firearms and Guns Act, 1931-1953,
