AN ACT to amend the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1954.

[Assented to 3rd October, 1956.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1956.*

(2) The Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1954,

is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be referred to as the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1956.

 - (b) by repealing subsection (8); and
 - (c) by deleting the passage, “or the registration of any orchard is transferred as provided for in this section,” in lines one, two, and three, of subsection (9).
