

## RESERVES.

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### AN ACT relating to certain Reserves and other Lands.

[Assented to 4th January, 1957.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Reserves Act*, Short title.  
1956.

2. Reserve No. 8485 at Busselton classified as of Class "A" and set apart for the purposes of "Camping, Park and Recreation" is hereby reduced by the excision of two areas, totalling one acre one rood and six and one-half perches, comprising—

- (a) Busselton Lot 340 of thirty and nine-tenths perches which is required for a separate reserve for Sea Scouts Building site; and

- (b) an area of one acre and fifteen and six-tenths perches, as shown coloured dark brown on Lands and Surveys Diagram No. 64001, which is required for the purposes of a public road.

3. Reserve No. 12919 set apart for the purpose of Camping and classified as of Class "A" is hereby cancelled with the intention that the land comprised therein be reserved for the purpose of a Rifle Range.

4. Reserve No. 1667 at Dalkeith set apart for the purpose of "Old Men's Home" and classified as of Class "A" is hereby reduced by the excision of that portion bounded by Jutland Parade, Beatrice Road and Iris Avenue, which is now designated as Swan Location 5837, with the intention that the portion so excised shall be set apart as a separate reserve for "Public Gardens and Park" and classified as of Class "A."

5. Reserve No. 11343 at Perillup, classified as of Class "A" and set apart for the purpose of a "Stopping Place" is hereby reduced by the excision of two areas being—

- (a) an area of about sixteen acres, comprising a strip of land two chains wide out of and along the eastern side of the reserve, which is required for road extension; and
- (b) an area of about ten acres to be surveyed as Hay Location 2231 which is required for a schoolsite and being the portion commencing at a point two chains west of a point on the eastern boundary of the reserve situated twelve chains fifty links north of its south-eastern corner and extending ten chains west, ten chains north, ten chains east and thence ten chains south to the starting point.

6. Reserve No. 12391, comprising Perth Suburban Lot 473, at Hay Street, Subiaco, which was constituted by the operation of section four of Act No. 27 of 1909, classified as of Class "A" and dedicated for the purpose of a schoolsite for the Seventh Day Adventists, is hereby cancelled with the intention that the land be reserved for the purpose of the body named Princess Margaret Hospital for Children Incorporated, and that a Crown Grant of the land be issued to that body in trust for hospital purposes.

7. (1) Reserve No. 9249 comprising Swan Location 2032 which was constituted by the operation of section two of Act No. 13 of 1904 and dedicated for the purpose of water supply is hereby reduced by the excision of an area of about eight and eight-tenths perches and now surveyed as Swan Location 5850.

(2) The purpose of Reserve No. 9249 is hereby altered to Recreation.

8. (1) Reserve No. 11785, comprising Leonora Lot 847, set apart for the purposes of a Hallsite for the Gwalia Branch of the Federated Miners' Union and leased to Daniel Bell, Thomas Butler and Charles Kiddie for a term of nine hundred and ninety-nine years in Lease 392/42 is hereby cancelled.

(2) The land comprised in the reserve so cancelled is hereby revested in Her Majesty as of her former estate with the intention that the land be disposed of in such manner as the Governor approves and is hereby authorised to approve.

9. Reserve No. 4991 at Bunbury, classified as of Class "A" and set apart for the purpose of Park Lands and under the control of the Municipality of Bunbury as a Board appointed under the provisions of the Parks and Reserves Act, 1895-1955, is hereby reduced by the excision of an area of about ten acres being the portion northward of the prolongation westward of the northern alignment of Roe Street, with the intention that the land so excised be set apart as a separate reserve for government requirements.

10. Reserve No. 13012 classified as of Class "A" and set apart for the purposes of Botanical Gardens, Park and Recreation and vested in the City of Perth in trust for such purposes is hereby reduced by the excision of Perth Lot 478, with the intention that the portion so excised shall be set apart as a separate reserve for the purposes of a Vehicle Park and Gardens, classified as of Class "A" and be vested in the City of Perth in trust for those purposes.

11. Reserve No. 23123 (Perth Lot 757) classified as of Class "A" and set apart for the purposes of Beautification, Recreation and Temporary Car Parking and vested in the City of Perth by virtue of section two of Act No. 38 of 1950 is by force of this Act set apart for the purposes of Vehicle Park and Gardens and is vested in the City of Perth in trust for those purposes.

12. (1) Reserve No. 23124 (Perth Lot 758) classified as of Class "A" and vested in the National Parks Board of Western Australia in trust for the purposes of Recreation and Beautification is by force of this Act set apart for the purposes of Vehicle Park and Gardens and is vested in the City of Perth in trust for those purposes, subject, however, to any rights of the Commonwealth or rights under the laws of the Commonwealth in respect of the land comprised within the reserve.

(2) This section shall come into operation upon a date to be fixed by proclamation.

13. The Governor is hereby authorised to grant to the Municipality of Claremont an estate in fee simple in the portion of Reserve No. 8002 (Swan Location 1798) to be surveyed as Swan Location 6156 free of any trust, and the Municipality shall have power to subdivide and sell the land subject however, to the provision that the net proceeds of any sale of the land shall be used in the development of the balance of Reserve No. 8002 so remaining.
