### AN ACT to authorise the reprinting of Acts.

[Assented to 18th December, 1953.]

**B**E it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Reprinting of Acts Authorisation Act, 1953.*

2. In this Act,

“Minister” means the Attorney General or during vacancy in the office of Attorney General, the Minister for Justice.

Minister may

3. (1) Where the Minister is of opinion that it is necessary or desirable to reprint

(a) an Act,

(i) the Bill for which has been printed as authenticated under the Joint Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly approved on the fifth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one as amended; and

(ii) which has not been amended;

(b) an Act printed as enacted pursuant to the Statutes Compilation Act, 1905; or

(c) an Act reprinted pursuant to

(i) the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938; or

(ii) the provisions of any other Act relating to the reprinting of an Act;

the Minister may direct the Government Printer to supply him with a printer's proof of a reprint of the Act as so printed or as so reprinted.

(2) If the Minister is satisfied that the printer's proof is a true copy of the Act as so printed or reprinted he may authorise the Government Printer to reprint the Act in accordance with the printer's proof and the Government Printer shall reprint the Act accordingly.

(3) In reprinting the Act the Government Printer

(a) shall print at the top of the first page the following:—

Reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Acts Authorisation Act, 1953, by the Minister's authorisation dated . . . ;  
and

(b) shall print after the word, "dated" the date of the Minister's authorisation.

4. Any Act reprinted pursuant to this Act shall in all courts and by all tribunals, bodies and persons be judicially noticed and deemed for all purposes to be an Act of the Parliament of Western Australia.

Judicial notice to be taken of reprinted Acts.

5. The provisions of this Act do not derogate from, or otherwise affect, the provisions of the Acts mentioned in paragraphs (b) and (c) of subsection (1) of section three of this Act.

Saving.
