AN ACT to amend the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1950.

[Assented to 18th December, 1952.]

BE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1952.* Short title and citation.

(2) The Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1950, Act No. 23 of 1914 as reprinted with amendments to and including Act No. 5 of 1939 incorporated pursuant to the provisions of the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938 and further amended by Acts Nos. 25 of 1946, 35 of 1947, 3 and 11 of 1949 and 3 of 1950, Reprinted Acts Vol. 2, 1943.

is referred to in this Act as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Plant Diseases Act, 1914-1952.

2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section thirty-nine of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words, "one shilling" in line seven the words, "two shillings". S. 39 amended.
