

**SHEEPSKINS (DRAFT ALLOWANCE PROHIBITION).**

**AN ACT relating to certain deductions known as draft allowance in connection with the sale of sheepskins.**

*[Assented to 14th November, 1952.]*

**BE** it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Sheepskins (Draft Allowance Prohibition) Act, 1952.* Short title.
  
2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.
  
3. A provision, express or implied, in a contract of sale of sheepskins entered into after the commencement of this Act, which provides for any deduction as or in the nature of a draft allowance from the weight of the sheepskins the subject of the contract of sale, shall be void and of no effect. Provisions providing for the deduction of draft allowance in contracts for sale of sheepskins void.
