

TOTALISATOR DUTY.

AN ACT to amend the Totalisator Duty Act, 1905-1946.

[Assented to 27th November, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Totalisator Duty Act Amendment Act, 1951*, and shall be read as one with the Totalisator Duty Act, 1905-1946 (Act No. 19 of 1905, as amended by Acts Nos. 8 of 1918, 24 of 1930, and 19 of 1946, and affected by Acts Nos. 19 of 1912 and 36 of 1920), referred to in this Act as the principal Act.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

2. The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Totalisator Duty Act, 1905-1951.

Commencement.

3. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation.

New subsection (1a) added to s. 3. Cf. No. 8 of 1918, s. 3; No. 24 of 1930, s. 2; No. 19 of 1946, s. 2.

4. The following subsection is added after subsection (1) of section three of the principal Act:—

(1a) On and after the coming into operation of the Totalisator Duty Act Amendment Act, 1951, the payments mentioned in the last preceding subsection shall be calculated at the rate of three and one-half per centum instead of the rate of seven and one-half per centum mentioned in that subsection in respect of every totalisator situate more than twenty-five miles from the General Post Office at Perth.
