*Acts Amendment (Increase in Number of Judges of the Supreme Court).* [No. 17.]

(4) Subsection (1) of section thirteen of the principal Act is repealed and substituted by the following:—

Amendment of s. 13. Cf. No. 52 of 1947, s. 4, (3), (c).

(1) The rate of the annual salary payable respectively to the Chief Justice of the State and to each of the other Judges of the Supreme Court shall be that specified in the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899, and any Act amending or substituted for it.

Constitution.

3. (1) This section shall be read as one with the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899 (Act No. 19 of 1899, as amended by Nos. 21 of 1904, 6 and 31 of 1911, 34 of 1921, 25 of 1927, 1 and 26 of 1929, 25 of 1933, 40 of 1934, 29 of 1942, 52 of 1945, 2, 4 and 52 of 1947, and 12 of 1948), referred to in this section as the principal Act.

Construction.

(2) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, 1899-1949.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

(3) Section forty-five of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "twenty-four thousand six hundred pounds" in line three, the words "twenty-six thousand nine hundred pounds".

(4) The Fourth Schedule to the principal Act is amended by—

(a) inserting between the words in lines twelve and thirteen the following words:—

(b) substituting for the figures "24,600" in line fourteen, the figures "26,900".
