

BASSENDEAN MARSHALLING YARDS.

AN ACT to authorise the Payment of Additional Compensation for Land to be Resumed for the Purposes of the Bassendean Marshalling Yards.

[Assented to 29th December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bassendean Marshalling Yards Act, 1950.*

Governor may pay additional compensation where dwelling erected on land resumed for marshall- ing yards.

2. Where a dwelling house is erected on any land taken under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1902-1945, for the purposes of railway marshalling yards to be constructed at Bassendean under the provisions of The Eastern Railway Act, 1878, the Governor may pay, in addition to the compensation payable under the Public Works Act, 1902-1945, such further sum as, taking into consideration the prevailing housing conditions, he considers adequate in the circumstances.
