### AN ACT to continue the operation of the Industries Assistance Act, 1915-1947.

[Assented to 18th November, 1948.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Industries Assistance Act Amendment (Continuance) Act, 1948.* Short title.

2. Section fifteen of the Industries Assistance Act Amendment Act, 1917 (No. 16 of 1917), is amended by substituting for the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine" the words "one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four". Amendment of s. 15 of No. 16 of 1917.

3. The Industries Assistance Act, 1915 (No. 27 of 1915), as amended by Acts Nos. 52 of 1915, 16 of 1917, 3 of 1918, 6 of 1919, 43 of 1919, 33 of 1920, 2 of 1922, 6 of 1923, 26 of 1923, 26 of 1924, 26 of 1925, 25 of 1926, 12 of 1927, 5 of 1928, 6 of 1929, 20 of 1929, 4 of 1930, 45 of 1931, 4 of 1932, 10 of 1933, 11 of 1934, 11 of 1935, 23 of 1936, 42 of 1937, 24 of 1938, 7 of 1939, 29 of 1940, 42 of 1940, 41 of 1941, 30 of 1942, 12 of 1943, 7 of 1944, 29 of 1945, 34 of 1946, 3 of 1947, and this Act may be cited as the Industries Assistance Act, 1915-1948.
