**AN ACT to amend the Western Australian Bush
Nursing Trust Act, 1936.**

[Assented to 5th November, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Western Australian Bush Nursing Trust Act Amendment Act, 1947*, and shall be read as one with the Western Australian Bush Nursing Trust Act, 1936 (Act No. 20 of 1936), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Western Australian Bush Nursing Trust Act, 1936-1947.

Citation of principal Act as amended by this Act.

3. For the purposes of this Act—

Interpretation.

“Association” means the Silver Chain District and Bush Nursing Association, a corporation incorporated under the provisions of the Associations Incorporation Act, 1895 (Act No. 20 of 1895).

4. At the request of the Trustees and of the Association and with the approval of the Honourable William John McKell, the Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, the fund, subject to all trusts, covenants, contracts and liabilities affecting it, is transferred to and vested in the Association.

5. The Registrar of Titles or the Registrar of Deeds, as the case may be, is hereby authorised, on receiving an application executed by the Trustees in respect of any of the lands held by them or held by any person on their behalf, to make an endorsement on the relevant certificate of title or other document of title, or enter a memorial in the Registry of Deeds, as the case may be, of the fact that the land is vested in the Association by force of this Act.
