

## LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (WAR TIME) ELECTORAL.

10° and 11° GEO. VI., No. XLV.

AN ACT to enlarge the definition of "Qualified Member of the Forces" in the Legislative Council (War Time) Electoral Act, 1943; to repeal section sixteen, and to continue the operation of the said Act.

[Assented to 24th January, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Legislative Council (War Time) Electoral Act, Amendment Act, 1946*, and shall be read as one with the Legislative Council (War Time) Electoral Act, 1943 (Act No. 35 of 1943 as amended by Act No. 32 of 1945), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. The definition of "Qualified member of the Forces" in section three of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the words "but within" in the fourth line, the words "Japan, Borneo or." Amendment of s. 3.

3. Section sixteen of the principal Act is repealed. Repeal of s. 16.

4. Section twenty-three of the principal Act is amended by deleting the word "forty-six" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-seven." Amendment of s. 23 and continuance of the principal Act.
