AN ACT to continue the operation of the Financial Emergency Act, 1934, as amended by the Financial Emergency Act Amendment Act, 1935.

[Assented to 30th September, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited at the *Financial Emergency Act Amendment Act, 1943*, and shall be read as one with the Financial Emergency Act, 1934 (No. 1 of 1934) (as amended by the Acts No. 26 of 1934, No. 19 of 1935, No. 18 of 1936, No. 17 of 1937, No. 25 of 1938, No. 10 of 1939, No. 27 of 1940, No. 24 of 1941, and No. 32 of 1942), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section seventeen of the principal Act (as amended by the Acts No. 19 of 1935, No. 18 of 1936, No. 17 of 1937, No. 25 of 1938, No. 10 of 1939, No. 27 of 1940, No. 24 of 1941, and No. 32 of 1942) is amended by deleting the words "forty-three" and substituting therefor the words "forty-four."
