No. 21 of 1939.**AN ACT to continue the operation of the Dried Fruits Act, 1926-1937.**

[Assented to 22nd November, 1939.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Dried Fruits Act Amendment Act, 1939*, and shall be read as one with the Dried Fruits Act, 1926-1937 (No. 49 of 1926 as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of Statutes for the year 1928 and amended by the Act No. 41 of 1937), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. (a) The principal Act as amended by this Act shall continue in operation until the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three, and no longer. Continuance of principal Act.
Duration.

(b) Section thirty-six of the principal Act (as amended by Acts No. 21 of 1929, No. 32 of 1931, No. 15 of 1934, and No. 41 of 1937) is amended by deleting the word "forty" in line two of the section and inserting in lieu thereof the words "forty-three." Amendment of s. 36 of the principal Act.
