

BOAT LICENSING.

AN ACT to amend Section four of the Boat Licensing Act, 1878.

[Assented to 11th December, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Boat Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1936*, and shall be read as one with the Boat Licensing Act, 1878 (42 Victoriae, No. 24), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title.

2. Section four of the principal Act is repealed and in lieu thereof a section is inserted as follows:—

Amendment of s. 4.

4. Nothing in this Act contained shall apply to any boat, ship, vessel, or steamer which is subject to the provisions of the Navigation Act, 1904-1926 (No. 59 of 1904).

This Act not to apply to boats, etc., subject to Navigation Act, 1904-1926.

3. The principal Act as amended by all Acts prior to this Act amending the principal Act and as amended by this Act may be cited as the Boat Licensing Act, 1878-1936.
