3. Section nine of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "Board" in line two of subsection (2) the following words:—

13. In the case of illness or other incapacity or absence from the State of the chairman or of any elective member of the Board, or of a vacancy in the office of the chairman or of any such elective member, the Governor may on the nomination of the Minister appoint some person to be deputy chairman, or in the case of an elective member, appoint some person to be a deputy member of the Board during such illness, incapacity, or absence or until such vacancy is filled.

5. A new section is added after section thirteen (as re-enacted) of the principal Act:—

13A. Notice of every appointment of the chairman or of a member or of a deputy chairman or a deputy member of the Board shall be published in the *Gazette*.

6. (a) The principal Act as amended by this Act shall continue in operation until the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty, and no longer.

Duration.

(b) Section thirty-six of the principal Act (as amended by Acts No. 21 of 1929, No. 32 of 1931, and No. 15 of 1934) is amended by deleting the words "thirty-eight" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty."
