AN ACT to amend Sections forty-seven and one hundred and one A of the Land Act, 1933-1936.

[Assented to 18th January, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Land Act Amendment Act, 1937*, and shall be read as one with the Land Act, 1933-1936 (Act No. 37 of 1933 as amended by Acts No. 47 of 1934 and No. 4 of 1936), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section forty-seven of the principal Act is amended by deleting the proviso to subparagraph (a) of paragraph (1) of the section and inserting in lieu thereof a proviso as follows:— Amendment of s. 47.

Provided that—

(i) for the purposes of this paragraph, five acres of grazing land shall be deemed to be the equivalent of two acres of cultivable land;

(ii) the Governor may reduce the maximum area that may be acquired in prescribed localities;

(iii) on the recommendation of the Minister and with the approval of the Governor, it shall be competent for persons in particular localities or in special cases to acquire an area of land in one or more parcels exceeding one thousand acres of cultivable land but not in any event exceeding two thousand acres of cultivable land or the equivalent thereof.

3. Section one hundred and one A of the principal Act (inserted by the Act No. 4 of 1936) is amended by inserting in subsection (1) thereof after the words "thirty-seven" in line five of the said subsection the words "or the year ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight."
