

LOTTERIES (CONTROL).

AN ACT to amend the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1935.

[Assented to 11th December, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Lotteries (Control) Act Amendment Act, 1936*, and shall be read as one with the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1935 (hereinafter called the principal Act).

2. Section fifteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding a further proviso to paragraph (b):—

Provided further that, in the case of all lotteries conducted by the Commission, the Auditor General shall make a continuous audit and report to the Minister from month to month.

Every such monthly report shall be tabled within fourteen days after making thereof in each House of Parliament, or, if Parliament is not then in session, within fourteen days after commencement of the next session.

Amendment of s. 21 of the principal Act.

3. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the word "thirty-six" in the second and third lines of the section and substituting the word "thirty-seven."

Citation of principal Act as amended.

4. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1932-1936.
