

MORTGAGEES' RIGHTS RESTRICTION CONTINUANCE.

1° AND 2° GEO. VI., No. XXXVIII.

AN ACT to continue the operation of the Mortgagees' Rights Restriction Act, 1931.

[Assented to 18th January, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Mortgagees' Rights Restriction Act Continuance Act, 1937*, and shall be read as one with the Mortgagees' Rights Restriction Act, 1931 (No. 19 of 1931), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. (1) The principal Act shall remain in force until the end of the month of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight and no longer.

(2) Section twenty of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "thirty-seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirty-eight."
