

WOOL (DRAFT ALLOWANCE PROHIBITION).

AN ACT relating to certain deductions known as Draft Allowance in connection with the sale of Wool.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Wool (Draft Allowance Prohibition) Act, 1936*, and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

2. Any provision, express or implied, in any contract of sale of wool entered into after the commencement of this Act providing for any deduction (as, or in the nature of, a draft allowance) from the weight of the wool the subject of the contract of sale shall be void and of no effect.
