

INDUSTRIES ASSISTANCE CONTINUANCE.

AN ACT to continue the operation of the Industries Assistance Act, 1915-1931.

[Assented to 26th November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Industries Assistance Act Continuance Act*, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Industries Assistance Act, 1915-1931, as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of the Statutes for the year 1931, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.
