

PERMANENT RESERVE.

24° GEO. V., No. XXXI.

No. 31 of 1933.

AN ACT to enable portion of Reserve A¹1162 to be excised therefrom.

[Assented to 27th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserve (A¹1162) Act, 1933.*

Power to excise portion of reserve A¹1162.

2. That portion of reserve A¹1162 (Perth town lot 55, Parliament House site) described in the Schedule to this Act may, with the approval of the Joint House Committee, be excised from the reserve for the purpose of widening Malcolm street.

THE SCHEDULE.

A strip of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the northern alignment of Malcolm street situate 246 degrees 53 minutes 3 chains 94 5/10th links from the eastern corner of reserve A¹1162 (Perth town lot H55), and extending 336 degrees 53 minutes 50 links; thence 246 degrees 53 minutes 10 chains 22 1/10th links to the tangent point of a circular curve, the bearing and distance of whose radius is 336 degrees 53 minutes and 75 7/10th links from said tangent point; thence by said circular curve north-westerly 1 chain 77 1/10th links to the eastern alignment of Harvest terrace; thence 200 degrees 58 minutes 2 chains 48 2/10th links to the said northern alignment of Malcolm street; and thence 66 degrees 53 minutes 12 chains 49 1/10th links to the starting point.
