AN ACT to continue the operation of Section ten A of the Traffic Act, 1919-1931.

[Assented to 4th January, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1933*, and shall be read as one with the Traffic Act, 1919-1931, as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of Statutes for the year 1930 and amended by Act No. 3 of 1931 and by Act No. 21 of 1932 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Continuation of s. 10A of principal Act.

2. Section ten A of the principal Act, as amended by Act No. 21 of 1932, is hereby amended by striking out the words "thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three," in the first and second lines, and inserting the words "thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four" in their stead.
