

CRIMINAL CODE (CHAPTER XXXVII.)

AN ACT to amend Chapter XXXVII. of the Criminal Code.

[Assented to 30th December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Code (Chapter XXXVII.) Amendment Act, 1932.*

Insertion of new section in Chapter XXXVII. of the Code.

2. There is hereby inserted in Chapter XXXVII. of the Criminal Code, after section three hundred and ninety, a new section as follows:—

Unauthorised use of vehicles.

390A. Any person who unlawfully uses, or takes for the purpose of using, or drives or otherwise assumes control of any vehicle as defined in the Traffic Act, 1919-1931, without the consent of the owner or the person in charge thereof, is guilty of a misdemeanour and is liable to imprisonment with hard labour for any term not exceeding three years.
