AN ACT to amend section eight of the Fruit Cases Act, 1919.

[Assented to 31st October, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Fruit Cases Act Amendment Act, 1932*, and shall be read as one with the Fruit Cases Act, 1919, hereafter called the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding a proviso to and at the end of paragraph (1) of that section, as follows:— Amendment of s. 8.

Provided, further, that the prohibitions contained in this section shall not apply to any case when it is being used solely for the carriage of grapes by rail to a point situated east of the No. 1 Rabbit-proof Fence.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Fruit Cases Act, 1919-1932. Citation of principal Act as amended.
