## AN ACT relating to certain Reserves and to revest certain grants of Land in the Crown.

[Assented to 30th December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Reserves Act*, 1932. Short title.
2. Class A reserve, number 20838, being Perth lot 435 (West Subiaco), at present dedicated to the purpose of "Recreation (children's playground)," is hereby dedicated to the purpose of "Recreation." Alteration of purpose

3. All that piece of land, being Wagin lot 55, the subject of Crown grant volume 243, folio 92, now standing in the names of Gerald Austin William Piesse and Charles William Chellow as joint tenants on trust for a mechanics' institute only, and set apart as reserve 6559, is hereby revested in his Majesty as of his former estate, to the intent that the said land may be reserved by the Governor and vested under Part III. of the Land Act, 1898, and its amendments, in the Wagin Municipal Council on trust for municipal purposes. 4. The dedication of Class A reserves 1206, 1208, and 1209, comprising Cottesloe lots 54, 57, 117, 118, 119, 120, 64, and 67 to the purpose of "Recreation," is hereby Cancellation of

and 1209.

cancelled, and the said lands are hereby declared to be Crown lands within the meaning of the Land Act, 1898, and may be disposed of accordingly.

Cancellation of grant to Armadale Rifle Club.

5. All that piece of land, being Cockburn Sound location 569, the subject of Certificate of Title volume 795, folio 59, standing in the names of Frederick William East, James William Turner, and Albert Cornish as trustees of the Armadale Rifle Club (now disbanded), and held by them in trust for the purpose of a rifle range, is hereby revested in his Majesty as of his former estate, and shall be deemed Crown land within the meaning of the Land Act, 1898.

A 1720 (King's Park). Excision of portion for continuation of Park road, Crawley.

6. Notwithstanding the provisions of section two of the Permanent Reserves (King's Park) Act, 1917, the area described in the First Schedule hereto (which is part of the area described in Part II. of the schedule to the said Act, the balance having been already added to Winthrop Avenue), is hereby excised from class A reserve 1720 (King's Park) and may be proclaimed a public road in continuation of Park road, subject to the provisions of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906.

A 1720 (King's Park). Excision of portions for purpose of widening Mount's Bay road.

7. Those portions of Class A reserve 1720 (King's Park), which are described in the Second Schedule hereto and delineated and hachured black on the plan in such Schedule, are hereby excised from such reserve to the intent that the portions so excised shall form portion of the public road known as Mount's Bay road and may be proclaimed as such under the provisions of the Municipalities Act, 1906.

South Perth A 5574— power of leasing conferred on South Perth Road Board.

8. Subject to the proviso in subsection (4) of section thirteen of the Reserves Act, 1926, reserve A 5574, at South Perth, set apart for public recreation, may be vested in the South Perth Road Board under section forty-two of the Land Act, 1898, with power to lease the same for recreation purposes for any term not exceeding twenty-one years, to take effect in possession not more than three months from the date thereof: Provided that any such lease shall reserve the rights of free access to the public at all times and shall be subject to the approval of the Governor.

**The First Schedule.**

That portion of reserve A 1720 commencing at the north-east corner of Perth Suburban Lot 490 and extending 345 deg. 5 min. 1 chain; thence 255 deg. 25 min. 1 chain 96 links; thence 179 deg. 37 min. 1 chain 3  $\frac{1}{10}$ th links to the north-west corner of said lot 490; thence 75 deg. 25 min. 2 chains 21  $\frac{9}{10}$ th links to the point of commencement, containing 33  $\frac{4}{10}$ th perches or thereabouts.

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**The Second Schedule.***Description of Land.*

All those portions of Reserve A 1720 being:—

*Part "A,"* containing an area of 18  $\frac{9}{10}$ th perches, and bounded by lines starting from a point on a North-eastern boundary of Perth Town lot L75 situate 128 deg. 34 min. 1 chain 83  $\frac{6}{10}$ th links from its northernmost corner and extending 52 deg. 6 min. 26 links; thence 56 deg. 12 min. 2 chains 63  $\frac{7}{10}$ th links; thence 54 deg. 13 min. 70  $\frac{8}{10}$ th links; thence 50 deg. 14 min. 52  $\frac{4}{10}$ th links; thence 224 deg. 20 min. 2 chains 56  $\frac{3}{10}$ th links; thence 236 deg. 49 min. 1 chain 48  $\frac{5}{10}$ th links, and thence 308 deg. 34 min. 43  $\frac{4}{10}$ th links to the starting point.

Part "B," containing an area of 1/10th perch and bounded by lines starting from the south corner of Perth town lot 469 (A 588) and extending 224 deg. 20 min. 39 5/10th links ; thence 38 deg. 18 min. 38 7/10th links, and thence 119 deg. 42 min. 4 2/10th links to the starting point.

All bearings being true or thereabouts and the measurements more or less, as the same are delineated on the plan hereunder and hachured black thereon.
