

TENANTS, PURCHASERS, AND MORTGAGORS' RELIEF (No. 2).

AN ACT to amend the *Tenants, Purchasers, and Mortgagors'* *Relief Act, 1930.*

[Assented to 30th December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Tenants, Purchasers, and Mortgagors' Relief Act Amendment Act, 1932 (No. 2).* Short title.

2. Section four and also section six of the *Tenants, Purchasers, and Mortgagors' Relief Act, 1930* (hereinafter called the principal Act), are hereby amended by the addition thereto of a subsection, as follows:—

(3.) In case the applicant is a woman the word "unemployment" in the last preceding subsection shall be deemed to mean "the unemployment of herself and/or of any person on whose earnings she is wholly or mainly dependent."

3. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion between subsections (1) and (2) of a subsection, as follows:—

(2a.) In case the applicant is a woman who is wholly or mainly dependent on the earnings of another person, then in lieu of satisfying the Commissioner, as provided in paragraph (a), it shall be sufficient if she satisfies the Commissioner that such other person has made all such reasonable efforts as aforesaid and that he is and has been unable to obtain employment through no fault of his own.
