

INTERSTATE DESTITUTE PERSONS RELIEF.

22° GEO. V., No. XXIV.

AN ACT to make provision in the Interstate Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1912, whereby a Territory of the Commonwealth of Australia and a Territory governed by the said Commonwealth under a mandate shall be deemed to be a State in the said Commonwealth for the purposes of the said Act.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interstate Destitute Persons Relief Act Amendment Act, 1931*, and shall be read as one with the Interstate Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1912, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. short title.

2. Section four of the principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by adding after the word “Australia,” in the definition of “Commonwealth,” the words “together with every Territory of the Commonwealth of Australia and every territory governed by the Commonwealth of Australia under a mandate”;
- (b) by inserting in the definition of “State,” after the words “any State,” wherever the same appear in the said definition, the words “or Territory.”
