AN ACT to amend section sixty-two of the Licensing Act, 1911.

[Assented to 29th December, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1931*.

Amendment of s. 62.

2. Section sixty-two of the Licensing Act, 1911 (as reprinted with amendments in the 1928 sessional volume of the Statutes), is hereby amended by the addition of a subsection, as follows:—

(3.) An application may be made at any time on or before the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, in respect of any house and premises approved or referred to by or in any provisional certificate which has been heretofore granted in the year nineteen hundred and thirty or nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and the time specified in any such provisional certificate (whether it has already expired or not) is hereby extended for all purposes to the end of the year nineteen hundred and thirty-two accordingly.
