AN ACT to amend section seventy of the Local Courts Act, 1904-1930.

[Assented to 17th November, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Local Courts Act Amendment Act, 1931*, and shall be read as one with the Local Courts Act, 1904-1930, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act." Short title. See No. 35 of 1930, s. 10.

2. (1.) Section seventy, subsection (5), of the principal Act is deleted. Amendment of s. 70.

(2.) Section seventy, subsection (6), of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "to the last preceding subsection and," in line one, and the words "(being within the same magisterial district as the place aforesaid)," in the last two lines.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Local Courts Act, 1904-1931. Citation of principal Act as amended.
