

PARLIAMENTARY ALLOWANCES.

AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Allowances Act, 1911.

[Assented to 16th December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Allowances Amendment Act, 1927*, and shall be read as one with the *Parliamentary Allowances Act, 1911*.

2. The allowance to the President of the Legislative Council, to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, to the Chairman of Committees of the Legislative Council, and to the Chairman of Committees of the Legislative Assembly, respectively, is hereby increased by one hundred pounds a year.
