

PUBLIC SERVICE APPEAL BOARD.

20° GEO. V., No. XXXVII.

No. 1 of 1930.

AN ACT to amend the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920.

[Assented to 6th January, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Appeal Board Act Amendment Act, 1929.* short title.

2. Section two of the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is amended by inserting after the figures "1906" in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) thereof the words "or as an officer of the field staff of the Forestry Department." Amendment of s. 2.

3. Section three of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "member" in the sixth line of paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the words "to represent the division of the Public Service concerned." Amendment of s. 3.

4. Section six of the principal Act is amended as follows:— Amendment of s. 6.

- (1) The word "or" in the fourth line of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) is omitted, and the words "the Managing Trustee of the Agricultural Bank, or

the Conservator of Forests," are inserted after the words "Minister of Education" in the fifth line thereof.

- (2) Paragraphs (d) and (f) of subsection (1) are repealed.
- (3) Paragraphs are added to subsection (1) as follows:—
 - (e) to hear and determine any appeal by the Civil Service Association on behalf of an officer appointed to a vacant position against a reclassification of such position made subsequently to the position being vacated;
 - (f) to hear and determine any appeal by the Civil Service Association on behalf of any public servant from the Commissioner, under sections forty-seven and forty-nine of the Public Service Act, 1904; and to adjust all such matters as aforesaid.
