

WAGIN HOSPITAL VALIDATION.

AN ACT to validate a certain building contract in connection with structural additions to Wagin Hospital.

[Assented to 19th November, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Wagin Hospital Validation Act, 1930.* Short title.

2. The building contract made the 6th day of December, 1927, between William Thomas May, of Wagin, as contractor, and the Joint Committee of Wagin Municipal Council and Wagin Road Board as the employer, for the construction by the contractor of structural additions to Wagin Hospital in accordance with the plans, specifications, and general conditions annexed to the said contract for the sum of five thousand four hundred and fifty pounds, and all things already done and hereafter necessary to be done by the said council and the said road board, and all payments already made and hereafter necessary to be made by the said council and the said road board in performance of the obligations of the said Joint Committee thereof under the said contract, are hereby validated, and the said contract shall be deemed to have been lawfully made, and the said Wagin Municipal Council and the said Wagin Road Board shall in all respects be legally bound by the said contract.
