

MUNICIPALITY OF ALBANY LOAN VALIDATION.

**AN ACT to render valid a certain Loan raised by the
Municipality of Albany.**

[Assented to 31st December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Municipality of Albany* Short title.
Loan Validation Act, 1924.

2. Notwithstanding any provision of the Municipal Validation of Loan.
Corporations Act, 1906, to the contrary, the loan of Three thousand pounds proposed to be contracted by the Municipality of Albany by a notice published in the *Gazette* on the 1st day of April, 1924, shall when effected be lawful and binding on the said Municipality, and the debentures to be issued in accordance with such notice shall be a valid security for the repayment of the loan.
