

PERMANENT RESERVES.

15° GEO. V., No. XV.

No. 15 of 1924.

AN ACT to enable defined portions of certain Public Reserves to be excised ; to authorise such portions to be reserved for other purposes ; and to amend section four of the Permanent Reserves Act, 1921.

[Assented to 9th December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserves Act, 1924.*

Reserve A 1306.

2. Narrogin Lot 343 is excised from Reserve A 11306 (Park Lands, Narrogin), and such lot may be reserved for a Presbyterian Church site in lieu of Narrogin Lot 80.

Reserve A 11377.

3. Broome Lot 585 is excised from Reserve A 11377 (Educational Endowment), subject to a lot in the same town-site, containing the same area (16 acres), being granted to the Trustees of the Public Education Endowment in lieu thereof.

Reserve A 1667.

4. The area described in the First Schedule is excised from Reserve A 1667 (Old Men's Home, Claremont), and shall be added to Reserve A 17391 for Recreation, South Nedlands.

5. The area described in the Second Schedule is excised from Reserve \wedge A17375, Swan (Crawley) Recreation, and may be granted to the University of Western Australia. Reserve \wedge A17375.

6. Section four of the Permanent Reserves Act, 1921, is amended by deleting the words "public refreshment rooms," and inserting in place thereof the words "a hostel." Amendment of Permanent Reserves Act, 1921, S. 4

7. Reserve \wedge A5183 (Subiaco), so far as the same is reserved for public buildings, may be dedicated to the purposes of recreation. Reserve \wedge A5183.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Sec. 4.

That part of Swan Location 2915 bounded by lines starting at the South corner of said location and extending $70^{\circ} 33'$, 2 chains 68 links; thence $63^{\circ} 3'$, 1 chain 4.4 links; thence $48^{\circ} 3'$, 1 chain 4.4 links; thence $33^{\circ} 3'$, 1 chain 4.4 links; thence $18^{\circ} 3'$, 1 chain 4.4 links; thence $3^{\circ} 3'$, 1 chain 4.4 links; thence $348^{\circ} 5'$, 1 chain 3.9 links to the Southern side of Birdwood Parade; thence $251^{\circ} 6'$, 45.7 links, and $254^{\circ} 40'$, 1 chain 39.2 links, along said side of said Parade; thence $214^{\circ} 6'$, 5 chains 69.8 links, and thence $180^{\circ} 2'$, 75.7 links, to the starting point. (Area 1a. lr. $39\frac{1}{10}$ per. Diagram 44632).

SECOND SCHEDULE.

That portion of Class "A" Reserve \wedge 17375 bounded by lines starting at the North corner of Swan Location 2885 and extending $75^{\circ} 18'$, 33.3 links, to a point on a circular curve whose centre is situate $309^{\circ} 57'$, 2 chains 11.3 links, from said point; thence South-Westerly along said curve 16.8 links to another point on another circular curve whose centre is situate $215^{\circ} 39'$, 25.1 links, from said point, and thence North-Westerly along said curve, 22.1 links, to the starting point. (Diagram 49590. Area $\frac{1}{10}$ ths of a perch). Sec. 5.
